Payment Methods

We accept South African issued VISA, MASTERCARD, and AMERICAN EXPRESS Credit Card Payments. We are presently unable to process foreign credit- or debit cards.

Clients who wish to buy online may pay via an EFT (Electronic Fund Transfer) by means of the Agrinet website alone.

At the time of placing the order, the transaction details are presented to the bank and an authorization is obtained for the amount of the order.

Payment is only collected when the order is completed.

Note that to protect its own and the interests of customers, Agrinet Limited scrutinizes all transactions very carefully to prevent attempted fraud and a transaction may be refused if Agrinet Limited is not satisfied with its legitimacy.

EFT payments

If the client selects the wish to use this method of payment, instructions will be given on how to deposit monies into the Agrinet Limited bank account subjected to the following rules:

- Payment must be made in full.
- The payment must quote the order number and surname in the reference section of the EFT.
- EFT payments must reflect in Agrinet Limited bank account before goods will be released.

Agreements of Sale

Placing an item in a cart without completing the purchase cycle does not:

- constitute an agreement of sale between Agrinet Limited and clients cannot hold Limited liable if such items are not in stock when the purchase cycle is completed later; and/or
- Constitute an order for such an item; and
- Agrinet Limited may remove such an item from the shopping cart if no stock is available.

An agreement of sale between Agrinet Limited and a client only comes into effect if and when:

- A credit card authorisation is received from the issuing bank; or
- An EFT is reflected on Agrinet Limited bank statement (and only if such payment is received).

Agrinet Limited reserves the right to refuse to accept and/or execute an order without giving any reasons. Agrinet Limited also reserves the right to cancel orders in whole or in part. Agrinet Limited shall only be liable to refund monies already paid by the Client and which deposits were cleared by the clients banking account.

Stock Availability
